Built by John H. Ackerman (#326)
Many of the stones came from Ackerman Creek North of Morton
From the farm at one time owned by Christian Ackerman(#1)
Located in the SW 1/4 of Land Section 4 in Morton Township

Marie and brother Ray Ackerman in 1927 at the stone gate built by John H. Ackerman from stones of a nearby creek on old Ackerman Farm. Notice the pig barn in the background with cupola and vents for air circulation. An automobile is heading toward the gate.
